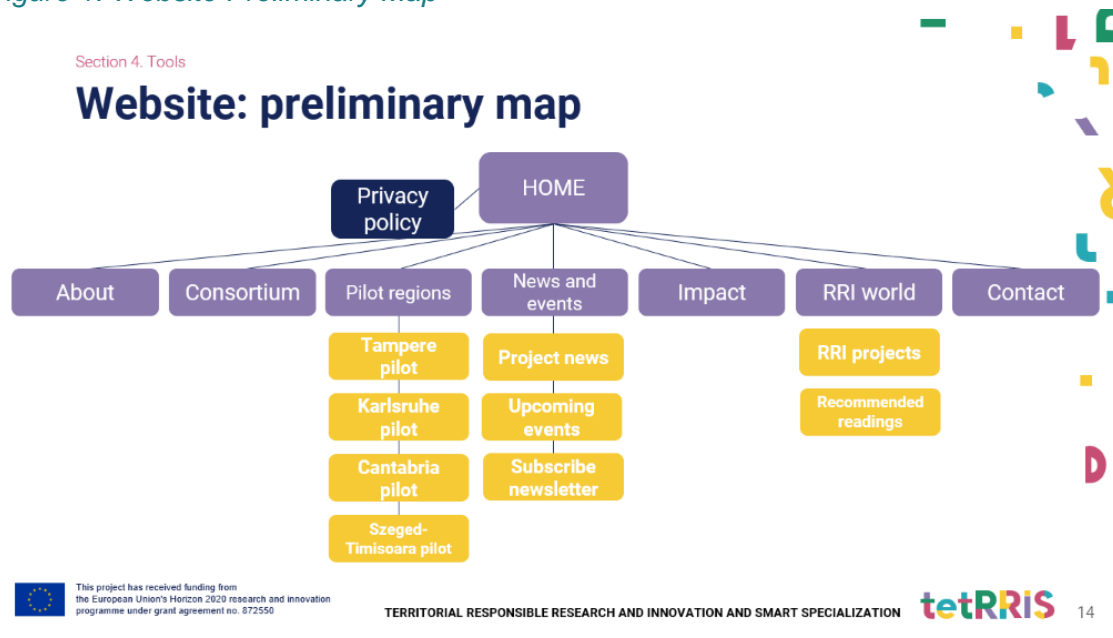
1. Executive Summary

Tampere, Karlsruhe, Cantabria, and Szeged-Timisoara are the central focus and these are the pilot regions/territoires through which the projects experiments will be channeled.

TetRRIS will marry RRI with S3 in the pilot regions with its activities centred on the project's pilot regions will go through several stages: indentifying and scoping; framing and orchestration; co-design, deployment and continuation; policy messages and scientific insights.

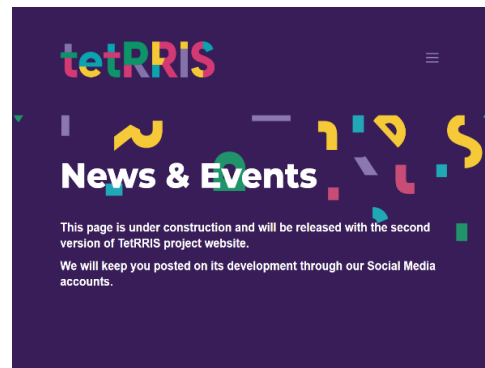

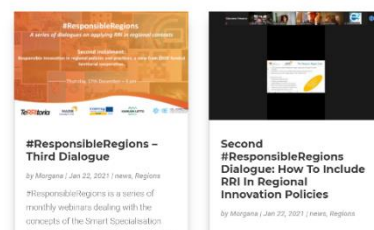

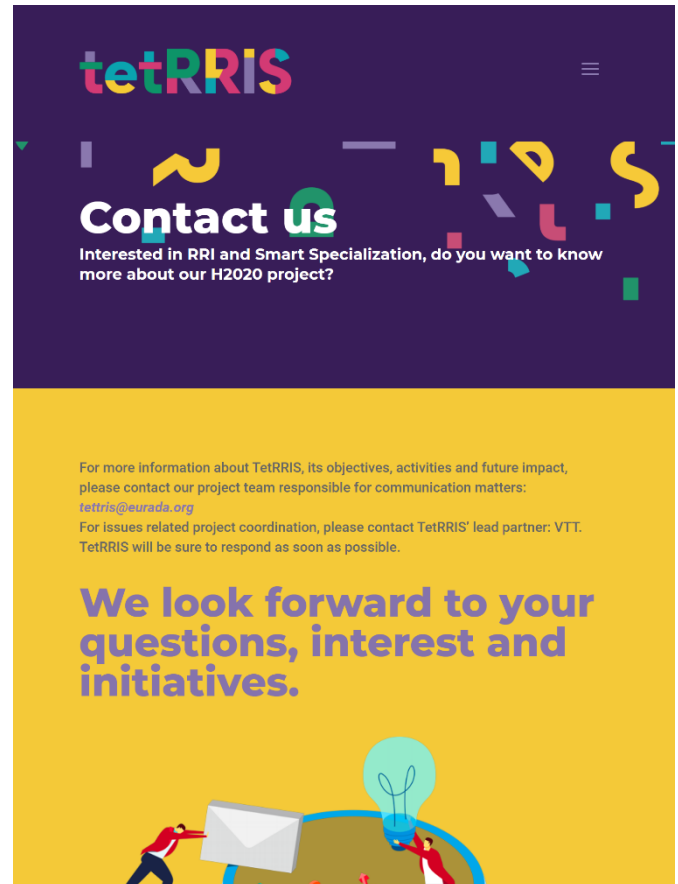
